After graduation he became Pastor of the Carrollton First Church of God in the Maryland Conference for three years and in 1993 became the Senior Pastor of the Chambersburg First Church of God in Pennsylvania where he continues to serve in that role. During his time at Chambersburg, he has received his Doctor of Ministry degree from Westminster Seminary in Philadelphia.

Earl has been married to Kim for 33 years and they have three adult children.
