Earl Mills is the Senior Pastor of the Chambersburg First Church of God in Chambersburg, Pennsylvania. He has been a part of the Churches of God since birth. He grew up on a dairy farm and came back to the farm after attending the University of Maryland, where he majored in Dairy Science. While a farmer Earl was a lay pastor for eight years and then at the age of 34, he was called into full-time ministry.

He attended Winebrenner Seminary and while at seminary, he was the Director for Youth Ministry for the Churches of God. After graduation he was the pastor at the Carrollton First Church of God in the Maryland Conference for 3 years. In 1993 he became the Senior Pastor of his current church. During his time at Chambersburg, he received his Doctor of Ministry degree from Westminster Seminary in Philadelphia.

The Chambersburg Church is very active in ministering in the local community including being instrumental in establishing a community work camp called *The Chambersburg Project*. The church also has a very strong mission focus which includes planting two churches in Brazil. A major emphasis has been given to reaching the un-churched and in the past two years there have been over 200 conversions at the Chambersburg Church. Attendance at the church is averaging 850 and the leadership of the church continues to seek the best way to take the tremendous message of the gospel to a world that desperately needs Jesus Christ.

Pastor Earl has been married to his wife Kim for 33 years and they have three adult children.



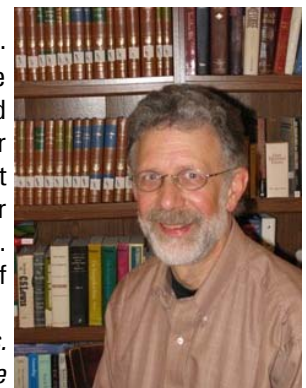
