He endured constant physical pain, discouragement, and humiliating public ridicule. Yet in the face of seemingly insurmountable obstacles, he emerged victorious! Through his relationship with Jesus Christ, he learned self-respect and acceptance of his physical challenges.

Although difficult to understand at first, David will capture our hearts with his quick wit and warm personality. We will laugh. . . and cry as we hear this inspirational man of God. As one who has not been stifled by his physical limitations, **he clearly stakes his challenge to everyone. "I have cerebral palsy, what's your problem?"**

Speaking to over 100,000 people each year, he has also been featured on nationally televised programs. David and his wife Karen, make their home in Nashville, Tennessee and they have 4 children, April, Ashley, Nathan and Amy Jo. David will be our keynote speaker on Tuesday evening, June 22.
